- All food entries must be on a dinner size paper plate with your name on the bottom of the plate and in a zip lock bag or secured clear wrap. 12 pieces or one whole pie, cake, loaf etc. All salsa, sauce, jam jellies, honey etc. must be in a mason jar labeled with a lid with your name on the bottom.
- All food entries become the property of the Agricultural Festival
- Categories may be combined or divided if deemed necessary in the best interest of the competition.
- Judging is closed to the public and is held at 12:00 on September 27th.
- Awards and returnable entries may be picked up on Sunday September 28th between 4-6pm. no edible items will be returned.
- Ribbons for 1st, 2nd and 3rd per category and in each age division
- Ribbons for “Champion” overall for: Homegrown, Foods, Sewing and Crafts, and Framed Art in each age division.
- One over all “Best of Show” in each age division.
