

**PARADE ENTRY FORM
RULES AND REGULATIONS**

PARADE

General Information

CHECK IN: 7:00 – 8:30 am. No entries allowed after 8:30 am

WHEN: Friday, July 4th Parade Starts @ 9:00 am

WHERE: San Jacinto Avenue @ San Jacinto Unified School District Offices

ENTRY COST: \$35/Entry, \$15/Non-profit

ENTRY DEADLINE: Friday, June 27, 2014

GENERAL GUIDELINES:

Parade entry form, liability waivers and general information will be available on the City of San Jacinto's website, www.ci.san-jacinto.ca.us

- The 4th of July Parade will travel north on San Jacinto Avenue at San Jacinto Unified School District Offices to Esplanade and head west to State Street and disband at Valley Wide Recreation & Park.
- **Check in time begins at 7 am. Please do not wait till 8 am to come. No late check in will be allowed.**
- The parade will start promptly at the designated start time, 9:00 am.
- Every participant in the parade must complete a liability waiver.
- Each entry **MUST** be decorated, either to the theme of the parade or Fourth of July in general.
- All entries should provide a banner, if possible, to identify their entry.
- Banners and signage affixed to, or carried in connection with parade entries, shall only indicate the name of the entrant.
- **Participants shall not distribute flyers, business cards or other materials to spectators along the parade route. Failure to follow this rule could result in your removal from the parade.**
- Discharge of fireworks and sounding of loud horns is prohibited.
- **Equestrian entries shall abide by the following:**
 - All horse trailers must be moved to the disbanding area before the parade begins. No Exceptions
 - Immediately clean up after horses along the route. All horses must have parade experience.
 - Please walk only; no trotting on parade route.
- All entries will be reviewed by the parade committee. The City of San Jacinto reserves the right to deny access to any parade entry that does not satisfy these guidelines or the theme of the parade.
- Motorcycles and Car entries...there is no exhibition of performance tricks allowed during the parade. No donuts, to tipping up on two wheels etc. Entries doing so will be immediately pulled from the parade, cited by the San Jacinto Police Department and not allowed to continue in the parade. Safety is our primary concern.

The intent of these guidelines is to establish rules to enable the staff to implement a successful and safe parade event that can be enjoyed by spectators and participants.

In case of accident or other emergency, personnel of the Public Works Department and/or its agents are hereby authorized to secure medical care deemed necessary as a result of accident or injury for the participant. I further agree to pay any and all costs incurred as a result of said treatment.
