



City of San Jacinto Water Conservation Notice



As per the Executive Order B-29-15 issued by Governor Jerry Brown
The City of San Jacinto has implemented its “Level 2 Water Supply Shortage Measures” outlined in the city’s municipal code section 13.04.070 “Water Conservation Ordinance No. 09-16”

- **Watering days**- 2 days a week. From November to March watering limited to one day a week
- **Watering hours**- No watering between the hours 9:00 am – 5:00 pm
- **Limit on watering duration**- 15 minutes per day per station
- **Excessive water flow /run off**- No water- flow/runoff allowed onto sidewalk, driveway, street, or gutter
- **No washing down hard or paved surfaces**- Only for cleanup of sanitary hazards
- **Leaks, breaks, malfunctions**- Must be repaired within 48 Hours
- **Decorative water features**- Must use re-circulating water
- **Limits on washing vehicles**- Must use a hand-held bucket or container. Hand-held hose with positive shut off nozzle/device
- **Drinking water provide by establishments**- Only if requested by customer
- **Commercial lodging**- Must provide guests the option to decline daily linen service
- **Single pass cooling systems**- Prohibited in buildings requesting new water service
- **Commercial car wash systems**- Must have a re-circulating water system
- **Limits on filling lakes or ponds**- Prohibited
- **Limits on filling pools & spas**- Re-filling of more than one foot and initial filling is prohibited
