Street Sweeping occurs year Round, so be sure to mark your calendars accordingly.

In July of 2015 the City of San Jacinto implemented a city wide street sweeping enforcement program. Street sweeping is considered to be a quality of life and an environmental best management practice as related to the National Pollution Discharge Elimination System (NPDES) programs. The process of street sweeping helps the City to remove trash, leaves and debris from the gutter system, thus reducing potential pollutants from affecting downstream watersheds while enhancing the aesthetic appearance of the residential and commercial neighborhoods. However, the effectiveness of the street sweeping program is severely hampered by parked vehicles, which prevent the sweepers from reaching the gutter line in order to accomplish an effective and efficient sweeping program.

The City is currently subject to implementing various efforts designed to reduce bacteria and nutrients under the Lake Elsinore / Canyon Lake Total Maximum Daily Loading (TMDL) which

was adopted by the Regional Water Board, and participates in the Comprehensive Nutrient Reduction Plan (CNRP) that was recently approved by the Regional Board in 2012. Enhanced street sweeping is a key component to compliance with both these water quality requirements. Last fiscal year the amount of street sweeping debris collected by our provider CR&R totaled 600 tons, equal to 1.2 million pounds!!!

In order to avoid receiving a street sweeping parking citation please do not park on the street when street sweeping occurs in your neighborhood as posted at entrances. **Street sweeping in residential areas occurs twice a month, except for holidays, year-round.**

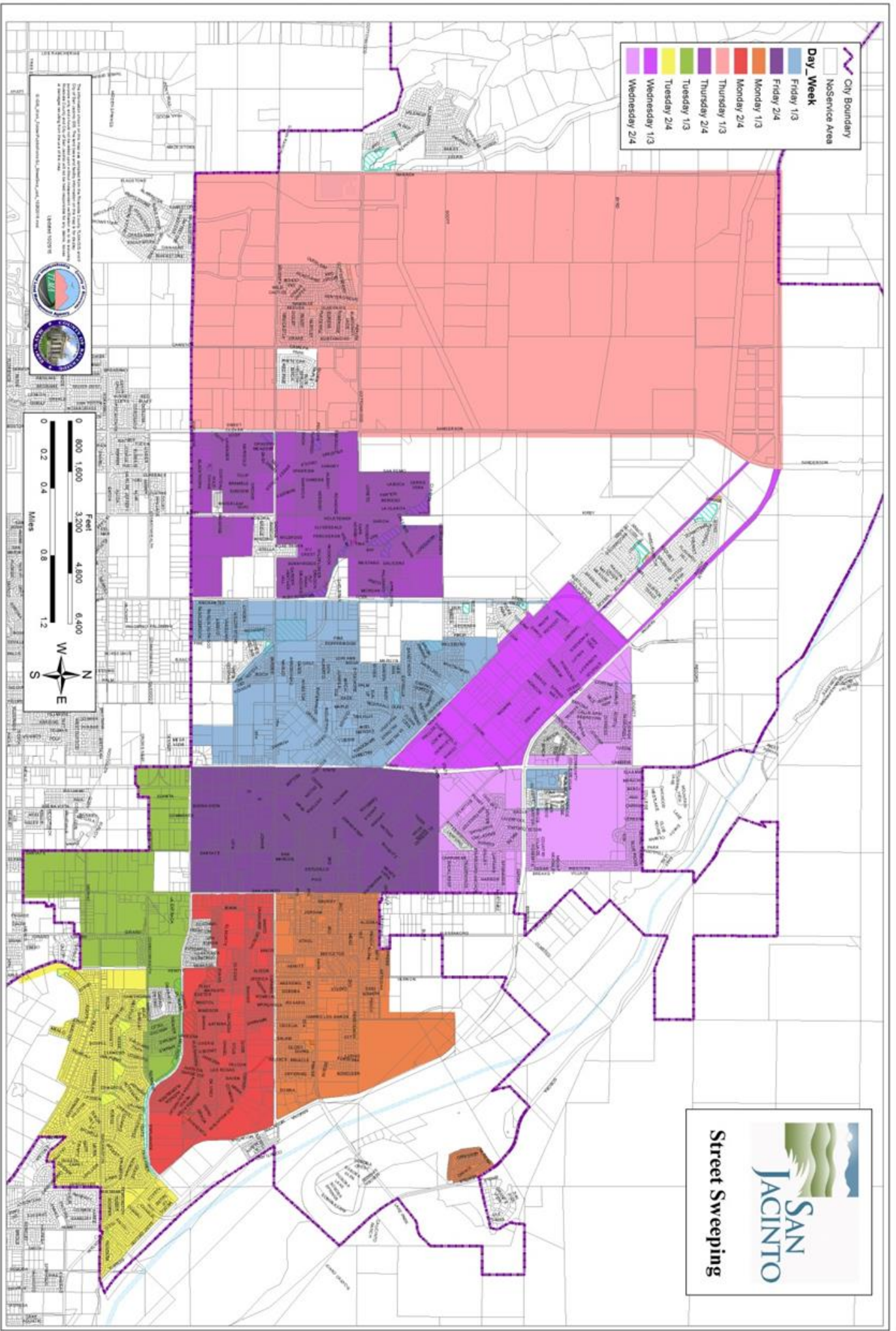
Be sure to "Mark Your Calendars" so that there is no confusion as to when street sweeping occurs. Please remember if visiting another neighborhood in the city to take a moment to review posted signage regarding street sweeping days and hours. For more information, please review the supplied map.



Here are a few key ways that you can help improve the cleanliness of your street and the quality of street sweeping:

- 1) Avoid piling leaves or other debris in the street or gutter*
- 2) Don't rake, sweep, blow leaves or other debris in the street or gutter*
- 3) Remove trashcans promptly after trash day and remove portable basketball hoops from the street*
- 4) Move vehicles off the street on street sweeping days.*
