Subject: **Neighborhood Meeting on February 10, 2007**

Dear Resident:

Thank you for attending the neighborhood meeting noted above. The City Council and staff greatly value your input and suggestions. It is important to note that collaboration amongst stakeholders helps make great communities.

The following represents the concerns and issues expressed by those in attendance and how those issues have or will be addressed by the City:

1. **Santa Fe Avenue Speeding:** The City of San Jacinto Police Department will enhance patrol on Santa Fe Avenue to help reduce the speeding problem. As indicated at the meeting, speeding is a serious issue in the City, generally the number one complaint at neighborhood meetings. The City Council is committed to protecting the safety of our residents, as evidenced by the installation of speed humps and other traffic calming devices in some neighborhoods. Unfortunately, due to the configuration and function of Santa Fe Avenue such tools are not available.
2. **Other Issues:** A number of issues were identified at the meeting including the striping of Santa Fe Avenue, a bike lane on San Jacinto Avenue, sidewalks on San Jacinto Avenue, and occasional patrols within the Park. These issues were discussed and addressed at the meeting and additional discussion in this letter is not needed.
