Residents of “Evans Street and Timothy Drive” area

Subject: Neighborhood Meeting on July 17, 2007

Dear Resident:

I want to thank you for attending the follow-up neighborhood meeting at Estudillo Elementary School on July 17, 2007. The following represents the significant concerns and issues expressed by those in attendance and how those issues have or will be addressed by the City:

1. **Neighborhood Security:** The Police Department and City Attorney’s office continue to monitor activities in this neighborhood. Furthermore, the City Attorney’s office has been in contact with the property owners of problem residences and informed them that it is their responsibility to ensure that their properties are not a nuisance and that all legal means will be utilized to correct any problems.
2. **Crosswalk @ Timothy and Shaver:** A Traffic Engineer has been hired to analyze the installation of a crosswalk at Timothy Drive and Shaver Street. He has already conducted a field survey at the end of a school day. Additionally, the Traffic Engineer and the City Engineer’s office have been in contact with the San Jacinto Unified School District administration to discuss ways to control access at nearby intersections to reduce hazards to pedestrians.
3. **Evans Street Speeding:** Evans Street has been added to the list of streets that will be surveyed to determine the appropriate speed limit. The speed surveys are currently underway and will be completed shortly.
4. **Parking on Evans Street at Hewitt:** The Traffic Engineer and the City Engineer’s office will analyze the appropriateness of the parking prohibition on Evans Street. If it is determined that parking should be prohibited, additional demarcation such as red curbing will be provided.
5. **Speed Humps on Timothy Drive:** The City Engineer’s office has determined that Timothy Drive meets the requirements for the installation of speed humps. As a result, a recommendation to install speed humps will be forwarded to the City Council in September.
6. **Bushes on Timothy Drive:** The bushes on the east side of Timothy Drive are scheduled to be trimmed in the next couple of weeks by either City crews or the City’s contract landscape maintenance operator. Thereafter, the bushes will be trimmed on a quarterly basis.
