

PLANNING COMMISSION VACANCY

The City Council of the City of San Jacinto is seeking applications from citizens interested in serving on San Jacinto's Planning Commission. The Planning Commission is a five-member body that provides recommendations related to land use and development issues facing the City Council. The Commission meets on the second and fourth Thursdays of the month. The person selected will complete the portion of an unexpired term, which will expire October 31, 2009. Commissioners receive a stipend of \$100 per month.

The Planning Commission is instrumental in San Jacinto's future: These commissioners weave the fabric of the community through the developing infrastructure, i.e. streets, parks, open space, retail centers, and storm drains. Citizens interested in serving their community on this important commission are encouraged to apply. Following an interview process by a council sub-committee, the City Council will make the appointment June 19, 2008.
