**The Belles of Bedlam** - are a musical comedy troupe that romp through the daily lives of a group of sisters who own an Inn.

**The Village Idiots** - love history and Shakespeare- they just can't seem to get their facts straight. The result is pure mayhem on stage.

**The Dancing Belly** - is a fusion of the many styles of belly dance. American Tribal Style, Tribal, Tribaret, Club Cabaret, Ethnic, Historical, Fantasy, Gothic, Modern and SO much more!

**Sound & Fury** - is a vaudeville-nouveau troupe of players, who present original comic plays. Using frequent audience participation and utter destruction of the 'fourth-wall,' Sound & Fury makes their works light & accessible, and non-threatening to a modern audience with limited attention spans.

**Imperial Knights** - recreate the thrill of a medieval joust. Dashing knights, beautiful damsels and trusty steeds are all a part of each exciting event!

First time fairgoers or seasoned rogues and wenches, in costume or in street clothes are all welcome to come out to the Ramona Bowl and enjoy the food, fun and festivities. Faire opens on the weekend of September 5th and runs every weekend through the 27th. There will be two opportunities to experience the renaissance at night, the second and fourth weekends. Faire hours are Saturdays 10am to 7pm, Sundays 10am to 6pm. On late night weekends, faire closes at 9pm on Saturday, and opens at 11am on Sunday.
