**Financial Assistance Offered
 To Homeowners Whose Homes Suffered Storm Damage**

SAN JACINTO, CALIFORNIA (January 7, 2011) The San Jacinto Redevelopment Agency has approved a resolution authorizing \$150,000 of redevelopment low- and moderate-income housing funds to help homeowners who sustained damage in the severe winter storms that began on December 17, 2010. This allocation has been authorized to assist low to moderate income households within the City Limits of San Jacinto to ensure that these homes are fit for habitation. Qualified Households must have incomes that do not exceed 120% of the Area Median Income:

Qualified homeowners are eligible for a grant of up to \$15,000 for repairs that are a direct result of weather related damage to the house that render the structure unfit for habitation.
