Auditions will be held with the ISC artistic staff on Sunday, April 3 starting at 11am, and Wednesday, April 13, starting at 7:30 pm at the Esplanade Arts Center, 2181 W. Esplanade Ave. in San Jacinto.

The Summer Repertory Festival includes:

“The Last five Years,” directed by Kristofer James

A contemporary song-cycle musical that ingeniously chronicles the five year life of a marriage, from meeting to break-up... or from break-up to meeting, depending on how you look at it.

Sing a song, bring resume and be prepared to read from the script.

2 characters: 1M/1F

Performances: July 15, 17, 21, and 23. Rehearsals start in early May.
A special reprised performance October 14, 2011

“Dog Sees God, Confessions of a Teenage Blockhead,” directed by Danny Guerrero

When CB's dog dies from rabies, CB begins to question the existence of an afterlife. A chance meeting with an artistic kid, the target of this group's bullying, offers CB a peace of mind and sets in motion a friendship that will push teen angst to the very limits.

8 characters: 4M/4W

Bring resume and prepare to read from the script. A monologue in verse is optional.

Performances: July 14, 16, 18, 20, and 22. Rehearsals start in early May.

CB: (CHARLIE BROWN) THE NARRATOR
CB'S SISTER: (SALLY BROWN) THE GOTH
VAN: (LINUS VAN PELT) THE PHILOSOPHER
MATT: (PIGPEN) THE BULLY
BEETHOVEN: (SCHROEDER) THE OUTCAST
TRICIA: (PEPPERMINT PATTY) THE PARTY GIRL
MARCY: (MARCI) THE SIDEKICK
VAN'S SISTER: (LUCY VAN PELT) THE THERAPIST

In addition, you may audition to be called back for ISC's on-going fundraiser:

"The Grapes of Laugh, or Whose Whine is it Anyway?"

This is your chance to show off your improvisational skills in a game show setting.

6 actors, any type + 1 host type- must be fearless!
