City of San Jacinto to Host Community Visioning Workshop

SAN JACINTO, CA – The City of San Jacinto will host a Community Visioning Workshop on Saturday, October 15, 2011 from 9:00 a.m. to 1:00 p.m. at the San Jacinto Community Center, 625 South Pico Avenue, San Jacinto.

The City is seeking participation by and input from the community related to the City's economic development programs.
