Emergency Senior Home Repair Program To Income Eligible Seniors

SAN JACINTO, CALIFORNIA (June 21, 2012) The San Jacinto City Council has approved the Fiscal Year 2012-13 budget and authorized \$20,000 to be allocated for an Emergency Senior Home Repair Program. Funds will be available July 1, 2012 to limited to income qualified seniors. This allocation has been authorized to assist low to moderate income households within the City Limits of San Jacinto to ensure that these homes are fit for habitation. Qualified Households must have incomes that do not exceed 120% of the Area Median Income:

Qualified senior homeowners and mobile home owners are eligible for a grant up to \$3,000 for emergency health and safety related repairs including:

Swamp cooler service/repair, Air Conditioner service/repair, Minor Roof Repairs, Electrical Repairs, Plumbing Repairs, and Handicap additions (i.e. rails and ramps)
