Beginning September 21st, 2012, a collaborative of community partners in Riverside County led by the District Attorney's Office will host The Lisa Project, a fully interactive multisensory experience that will take you beyond the headlines and statistics about child abuse. This audio tour and media exhibit will lead you on a journey through the lives of children plagued by abuse.

At no other time has anyone had the chance to understand the plight of these children and to experience it through their eyes, their ears and their emotions. The Lisa Project promises to raise awareness through education and outreach as you "take a child by the hand" and listen to their story. Some secrets should be told.
