JEFF LINSKY, "GUITARISTS' DREAM", FOR THIRD SUNDAY

Award-winning guitarist Jeff Linsky returns, by popular demand, for the next "Third Sundays" concert November 18, 2012. Presented by the Diamond Valley Arts Council, the 6:30 p.m. concert will be held at the Esplanade Arts Center in San Jacinto. Celebrated for his remarkable improvisational skills and an endless repertoire of music from around the world, Jeff will be sharing music reflective of his international concert career.

Having recently returned from performances in Mexico City, Linsky will also feature music from his new recording "Mexico," a collection of popular Mexican boleros and ranchera music. Jeff was named an "Honorary Hispanic" by Latin Beat Magazine. Also an award-winning composer, Jeff's music has appeared in film, radio and television on several continents. According to Guitar Player Magazine, "Linsky's talent is the stuff guitarists' dreams are made of."
